

Coast Guard Mutual Assistance Supplemental Education Grant (SEG)



The SEG reimburses various course-related costs including books, equipment, and fees.

Each SEG applies to the current calendar year, regardless of when costs were incurred.

Applications must be processed within 366 days of purchase date.

Grants may be awarded up to the authorized amount throughout the calendar year.



Student Eligibility

All CGMA Clients may apply for the SEG on behalf of themselves or their eligible family members.

The student must be:

- Enrolled in an undergraduate or post-graduate degree program
- Pursuing a VoTech program approved by the Department of Veterans Affairs or Department of Education
- Seeking a General Equivalency Diploma (GED)
- May not be used for dependents in high school or grade school

Qualifying Expenses

This includes the cost of normal fees, books, study guides, supplies, equipment and other documented educational costs directly related to the course of study.

Reimbursable Items Include

- Art Supplies
- Audio/Visual Tapes
- Computer Software
- Computers
- Course Specific Software
- Fees
- Graduate/Post Secondary Level Tests (LSAT, MCAT, GRE...)
- Lab Books
- Laptops And Tablets
