THE CGMA DIFFERENCE

CGMA helped my family by covering a large part of a car rental bill we unexpectedly had to pay out of pocket. It truly lifted a burden off our shoulders.

I originally thought I was applying for a loan, but to my surprise, CGMA awarded me a \$1,000 grant to help offset the \$1,200 out-of-pocket cost of a car rental during PCS season. That unexpected support meant so much to my family and me and made a real difference in our OCONUS transition.

The entire process was incredibly fast, professional, and supportive. My local Representative reached out to me right away—before I even had a chance to call. Chief Mix was especially helpful, taking the time to answer all my questions with care and clarity.

If we hadn't received this grant, we would've been paying the full cost of a month-long car rental—something we simply weren't prepared for. It would've put a real strain on us during an already overwhelming time.

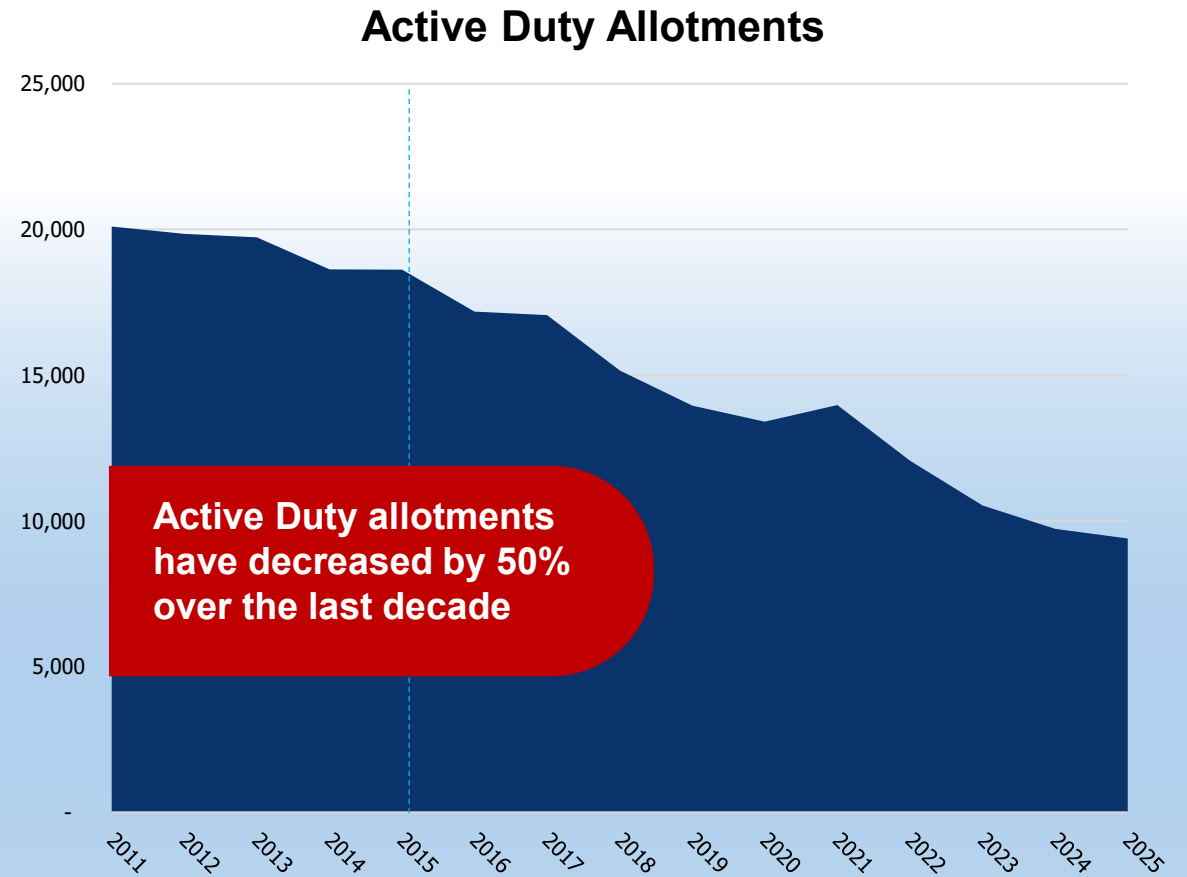
